GENERAL ENGLISH

Communicative teaching methods and a friendly international environment make learning English at Liverpool School of English a pleasurable and enriching experience. Students take a placement test on arrival to assess their ability in English and are then placed in the appropriate class.

General English classes introduce the main linguistic concepts used in everyday communication such as structure, syntax, vocabulary and pronunciation. The focus is on English for spoken communication, however all skills are taught.

You work to familiarise yourself with colloquial and standard English and how to use it in everyday situations such as in the home, in the bank, whilst shopping, eating out or on the telephone. Higher level courses build on this work to include more advanced vocabulary and language skills.



Teachers assess each student's needs and ensure optimum progress.

STANDARD COURSE

(15 hours per week)
Three hours each day covering all skills areas.

INTENSIVE COURSE

(21 hours per week)
An extra two 3 hour workshops each week focusing on a specific area of language.

The standard course is made up of five 3 hour learning blocks per week, either in the morning or afternoon. Each 3 hour learning block will have a short 15 minute break.
