How to enrol and pay for your course:

If you want to study at Liverpool School of English we accept bookings in the following ways:

- Directly via our website www.lse.uk.net or by sending a registration form to admissions@lse.uk.net
- Through one of our Educational Tour Operators (ETO) located around the world. If you book through an ETO you are the client of that ETO rather than the school and any significant amendments, queries, complaints and payment issues should be sent to the ETO.
- We may pass on your enquiry to an education tour operator we work closely with. They offer our best possible prices and can provide fast expert advice on all our courses and services. They can answer all your questions in your own language to ensure communication is clear and comprehensive

If you are booking your own course:

- Arrange to pay the registration fee of £65 to Liverpool School of English. Make sure that you say who the payment is from and what it refers to.
- When we receive your registration form we will send you an email and an invoice.
- All Fees and charges must be paid in full prior to commencement of any course.

Payment:

- All fees including your refundable damage deposit are payable in pounds sterling (£) and payment can be made online – visit www.lse.uk.net/pay-your-fees and follow the instructions.

Course cancellation fees are as follows:

- Once a student has arrived in the UK, a minimum of one term's notice (in writing) is required, or payment offer in lieu of notice, whether or not the student continues to attend lessons. If withdrawal is due to refusal of a visa extension, then less notice may be accepted at the discretion of the Directors if full written details are provided prior to the start of the course. Where withdrawal is due to illness, if the student has taken out comprehensive insurance, they may be able to claim a refund accordingly. Notice of withdrawal must be given in writing and is effective from the date it is received by the registrar.
- If a student's application for a visa is refused, the student's tuition fee will be refunded after deducting the £250 Registration fee, provided all the following conditions are met:
 - The student has informed LSE in writing of his/her inability to start the course at least two weeks prior to the commencement date.
 - That the visa application met UKVI requirements.
 - The student has not entered the UK
 - The original letter issued by the British Embassy confirming the grounds for refusal has been provided.
 - The student has not appealed against the refusal of the visa; if an appeal has been lodged, the fees will be refunded only after receiving documentary evidence that the appeal has been dismissed
 - The original SVV letter or CAS letter and receipt for the fees paid are returned in their original form.
 - That the claim for a refund is made within 3 months of the documented refusal decision

Accommodation cancellation fees are as follows:

- Cancellation more than 14 days before the start of the accommodation – Full refund.
- Cancellation less than 14 days before the start of the accommodation – 1 week of accommodation is payable to the school.

Postponements

- If a booking is postponed within 7 days of the arrival date, cancellation charges apply as detailed above.
- If a booking is postponed more than 7 days prior to the arrival date, no charges apply for your first above.

Insurance

- Liverpool School of English is working in partnership with Guard Me, to provide our students with a policy which has been specifically designed to meet your requirements whilst you are studying in the UK.
- We strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance at the time of booking the trip as cover will commence for pre-departure cancellation from the date accepted for cover. This will, therefore, provide cover should the trip have to be cancelled for an insured reason such as illness or serious accident preventing travel.
- If international student travel insurance has not been requested through Liverpool School of English, students must arrange their own suitable travel insurance and travel with all relevant policy documents upon arrival to the UK.
- It is compulsory for all students to have health and travel insurance before leaving their home country.

Terms and Conditions:

- Enrolment on a course with LSE constitutes a binding agreement on the student to attend all classes, lectures and examinations and to abide and comply with the schools' rules and regulations. As a student you will be expected to submit all written work before the deadline and pay any prescribed exam or other fees before the specified deadline
- The information on LSE's prospectus is correct at the time of printing and students are advised to contact the school to confirm course availability and fees.
- LSE endeavors to start each course on a specified date and reserves the right to delay, modify or withdraw any course after the published date for any reason without prior notice. An alternative course or subject will be made available or a pro rata refund of the course fees returned
- It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the correct visa type and appropriate leave to remain in the UK. In the event that we find that you do not have appropriate leave to remain, we will terminate the course immediately. In this case, tuition and registration fees are non-refundable. Information on visa types can be found on the Home Office website: www.gov.uk/government/organisations/uk-visas-and-immigration
- Students under the age of 18 are children in British law. If any student under the age of 18 wishes to study at LSE, the person or people with parental responsibility for them in their own country must complete a consent form and return it to the Admissions Team with a copy of their ID. This form outlines the rules and conditions that will apply for LSE to accept a booking for a student under 18. The form can be obtained from the school or from your ETO.
- LSE takes attendance extremely seriously and has a 100% attendance expectation (excluding any

authorised absences). Additionally, and in consideration of UKVI requirements, LSE has set a requirement that for overseas students on a student visa, must maintain a minimum of 95% attendance record and that failure to do so may result in exclusion from LSE and reported to UKVI

- If a student is absent through ill health, a medical certificate must be supplied.
- Students must notify the college immediately if there is any change in personal details from those provided in the application or enrolment form

- If you want to cancel or postpone your course, you must request this in writing to the school or your ETO. The registration fee is non-refundable. Where accommodation has been booked, the accommodation booking fee is non-refundable.
- If you have to stop their course early, tuition fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.
